The first three sessions will be taught by Niki Giberson at her folk art school and sheep farm, Swan Bay Folk Art Center, in Port Republic, located at 300 Sooy's Landing Road. Giberson has a B.A. in Early American Crafts and Culture from Stockton University and specializes in basketry and wool crafts using fiber from her own sheep.
